Students, faculty, and staff at Virginia Intermont continued and expanded their commitment to community service and service learning in the 2004 -- 2005 year.

- Again noteworthy was the participation of the entire freshman class in GIVE day during their orientation period. Several needed projects were completed at Steele Creek Park.
- Dozens of student, faculty, and staff volunteers supported the Rhythm and Roots festival again. In 2004-05 VIC had more volunteers than any other community group.
- On our other major service front, Alpha Phi Omega continues to work on its charter as a National Service Fraternity, led by group leader Nicole Frazier and other petitioning members. They have set a charter date for September 11, 2005.
- Several students and staff assisted the Bristol Virginia Housing Authority with a new initiative, Find-a-Way Day.
- The community Christmas Party was held on Intermont's campus with the Bristol Virginia Housing Authority, Impact International- , and the Intermont

Social Work Club taking the leadership roles. Scores of VI students volunteered for this event.

The college continues to provide service to other organizations, but the committee suggests that more service to fewer organizations may have greater impact. The committee will work to continue this directive in the 2005- 06 year.
